He refined his craft touring with Joe Herman in West Virginia and is also a fine singer, performs with Shirley Collins, is a member of Rattle on the Stovepipe and with Richard Bolton, and is the best-selling author of *The Complete Irish Fiddle Player* (Mel Bay Publications), as well as five acclaimed tune collections for Schott Music - Irish, English, Eastern European, American Old Time and original tunes of his own. In February Rattle on the Stovepipe headlined at the FOAOTMAD festival in Gainsborough and will also be performing 2 Bunkfest Fringe sets on the Sunday including the Rowse Honey stage right after his workshop
